Human Slot Machine instructions

Create the slot machine

1. Use 3 trifold presentation boards
 - In each trifold cut a large window in the middle board
 - Open each trifold board and connect so that there are three windows and volunteers cannot see each other
 - Decorate outside as preferred
 - See photo for reference or view DIY instructions on YouTube (search human slot machine DIY)



Setup

1. Choose 3 volunteers to be the “reels.”
 - Have them stand behind a the trifold dividers so they can’t see each other.
 - They’ll each hold a random object (like colored cards, shapes, or themed items).
2. Decide on the items that are easy to pick up quickly (e.g., hand fans)
 - Each reel person picks one item at random for each spin.
3. Set up a play area and display any rules or prizes clearly for participants.

How to Play

1. Player steps up rings the bell to begin and end the round.
 - This mimics pulling the slot machine lever.
2. Each volunteer reveals their item at the same time, like reels stopping.
 - They should show their chosen item together so players can see all three.
3. Check for a match:
 - Three matching items = a win.
 - Anything else = no win this spin.

Winning & Prizes

- If the player gets three of the same object, they win a prize.
 - Prizes can be small fun items, tokens, or something appropriate for your workplace.
- You can run multiple spins per player or let players take turns until everyone has had a chance.

Tips for a successful event

- Inspiration for the activity came from Instagram; social media can be a valuable resource for creative events.
- Create a flyer to promote your event.
- Give each participant a number to keep the game orderly.
- Please adhere to agency fundraising policies if considering including a fundraising component. (Ex. two free spins)
- Use simple props, such as printed shapes, cards, or items familiar to your team.
- Keep the energy lively by using a bell or sound cue before each spin.
- Rotate volunteers so everyone has an opportunity to participate in the game.
